ORDER:

The Hon'ble Chief Minister has announced in the Vision 2023 document to make the cities in Tamil Nadu Slum Free by 2023. To achieve this objective and also to cater to housing needs of economically weaker sections, various housing programmes have implemented under State and Government funded programmes in Corporations and Municipalities of Tamil Nadu such as JNNURM, IHSDP, BSUP and RAY. In the rural areas, Government have implemented various housing programmes economically weaker sections such as IAY and Chief Minister's Solar Powered Green Houses scheme. However, no major initiative in Housing sector has been undertaken in Town Panchayat areas.

There are 528 Town Panchayats in Tamil Nadu which exhibit both urban and rural character and are an important component of rapid urbanisation in Tamil The rate of growth of population in Town especially around maior municipal **Panchayats** these corporations is very high. Hence, special focus in terms panchayats require development of infrastructure and housing. Though town panchayats have achieved urban character, due to unequal growth in income levels substantial population of most of the town panchayats still live in kutcha and semi pucca houses. Further, due to growth of family size and consequent increase in population pressure, existing dwelling sizes have been rendered smaller and smaller and exist next to each other without much spacing and formation of proper streets etc. Hence, some of the areas of town panchyats start exhibiting the character of slums. Also, large number of people working in municipalities and corporation areas who cannot find affordable housing near their work places prefer cheaper housing options adjacent town panchayats. This adds further pressure on availability of affordable and hygienic housing in town panchayats.
- 3. In order to cater to the growing demand for housing in the Town Panchayats for economically weaker sections it is proposed to initiate a new housing scheme with funding from the State Government. In order to provide flexibility in design and construction, speedy completion of houses and ensuring transparency in execution, the scheme is proposed to be implemented through beneficiary led construction model. Financial assistance of Rs.2.1 lakhs per family to convert huts/mud houses into green houses with a concrete roof and solar power will be provided.

Eligibility:

In order to be eligible to receive assistance under the scheme the applicant should be poor and should not own any concrete house. The assistance will be provided to construct a house with a plinth area of not less than 300 sq.ft.

Detailed guidelines regarding eligibility, selection of beneficiaries and maximum plinth area of the proposed house will be decided by a committee of Secretary, Housing and consisting Development, Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board, Director Town Panchayats and a department under the representative of finance Chairmanship of Principal Secretary, Municipal Administration and Water Supply Department. The committee will also decide regarding applicability of building plan parameters and building plan approval process.

Applications:

beneficiaries submit their Eligible can applications to the respective Town Panchayats along with Income Certificate and Building Plan, which will be scrutinized by the Executive Officers of the Town Panchayats. After scrutiny, they shall accord approval for selection of beneficiary as per the criteria discussed prescribed by the committee Supervision of construction shall be carried out by the Assistant Executive Engineers of Town Panchayats and stage wise construction shall be monitored by them. The scheme envisages only stagewise completion certificate by the respective Assistant Executive Engineers of Town Panchayats for the purpose of release of payment to the beneficiaries. Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board will release funds to the town panchayats on quarterly basis and supervise over all progress of the scheme. Details of stagewise payment to individual beneficiaries and release of funds by

Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board to the respective town panchayats and reconciliation process etc. will be worked out jointly by the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board and Director, Town Panchayats.

Implementing Agency:

Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board will be the implementing agency for the scheme. The Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board will obtain a loan of Rs.420 from Housing and Urban Development Corporation (HUDCO) / National Housing Bank which offer low rate of interest for EWS housing with Government Guarantee, in order to assist 20,000 families under Phase-I. In turn Tamil Nadu Slum Board offer can assistance beneficiaries at the rate of Rs. 2.1 lakhs in installments proportionate to the progress construction. Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board will repay the loan to HUDCO though sale of Transferable Development Rights (TDR) accrued due to the construction of EWS housing in market. The Executive Engineer, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board of the concerned region will be the sanctioning authority.

Monitoring:

A District Level Monitoring and Review Committee headed by the District Collector will monitor the implementation of scheme. Executive Engineer, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board will be the Convenor of the DSMRC.

4. After careful examination, the Government have decided to sanction financial assistance of Rs.2.1 lakh each to 20,000 Economically Weaker families in the Town Panchayats under Phase-I to convert huts/mud houses into green houses with a concrete roof and solar power. Government also permit Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board

to obtain sanction of a loan of Rs.420.00 crore from either HUDCO or National Housing Bank whichever offers the lowest rate of interest and get the loan released in instalments based upon the demand assessment. The Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board will repay the above loan and interest charged through sale of Transferable Development Rights (TDR) accrued due to the construction of EWS houses at periodic intervals as per the loan repayment schedule prescribed. The above loan will be backed by Government Guarantee.
